<p style="text-align: center;">Rolled Brim or Earflap Hat</p> <p>Learn how to join stitches to knit your hat “in the round” with any size yarn for any size head. Participants may need to return in order to complete decreases and to pick up stitches, if making an earflap hat.</p>	B	2	\$ 15
<p style="text-align: center;">Stay-On Angora Baby Booties</p> <p>A little rib, pick up some stitches, a little garter – all on single point needles. Be adventurous and do both booties at one time!</p>	AB	2	\$ 15
<p style="text-align: center;">Simple Lace Patterns</p> <p>The Calaveras Needle Arts Guild offers a <i>Learn To Stitch</i> workshop provided by The Knitting Guild of America. Participants are provided an opportunity to use three different styles of charts – charted, “in other words” and tabular form. <i>Bring a selection of worsted & sport yarn and size 6, 7, & 8 needles.</i></p>	AB	3	\$ 25** **Proceeds will be donated to CNG.
<p style="text-align: center;">Crocheted Beret</p> <p>Select the spiral or join method to create a stylish topper. Also, learn to increase and decrease while working in the round.</p>	B	3	\$ 25
<p style="text-align: center;">Sample Stitch Purse – knitability Series</p> <p>This workshop is designed for the newer knitter, particularly those who have little or no experience with the purl stitch. The sample stitch purse begins with several rows of purling to get comfortable with the stitch followed by several simple stitch patterns utilizing a combination of knit and purl stitches. The purse is knit in a single piece and then folded and seamed to form the purse shape. <i>Pre-requisite Skills:</i> Cast On, Knit & Bind Off</p>	B	4 2 – 2 Hr Sessions	\$ 30 Plus “Class In A Bag”
<p style="text-align: center;">Baby Life Ring Socks</p> <p>These toe-up socks are knitted on two circular needles – as designed by Cat Bordhi, author of “Socks Soar On Two Needles. The rolls on Life Ring Socks resemble life preserver rings. They can be bunched down to fit around the ankle or pulled up like a knee sock. Made of an elastic yarn – enjoy the thrill of knitting with Heirloom Breeze – 30% wool, 69.6% cotton, .4% lycra. Just takes one ball to make a pair for newborn, 3 or 6 month old baby. Learn wrap & turn (short row) technique to turn the heel. Participants will also learn to do a provisional cast-on using the second needle instead of scrap yarn.</p>	AB	4 2 – 2 Hr Sessions	\$ 30

<p style="text-align: center;">Top Down Sweater – knittability Series</p> <p>This workshop is designed for the knitter who would like to familiarize themselves with the techniques associated in knitting a garment from the top as opposed to the “traditional” method of bottom up. Some of the key concepts include flexible cast on and bind off methods, instructions for double increases and mirrored decreases. Previous experience in knitting garments is not required, although may be helpful. To keep the quantity of knitting manageable, only baby/toddler sizing is offered. However, techniques covered will easily translate into other garments.</p> <p><i>Pre-requisite Skills</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knit, Purl and simple knit/purl combinations • Familiarity in working in the round with DPN and circular needles • Counting rows & stitches (gauge) • Familiarity with garment construction helpful 	AB	4 2 – 2 Hr Sessions	\$ 30 Plus “Class In A Bag”
<p style="text-align: center;">Dyeing Fibers</p> <p>This workshop is designed to introduce participants to fiber dyeing. Using Kool-aid, we will vat dye spun yarn with solar power. And, using food coloring, we will apply dyes to roving and then cook in the microwave. No acids, except vinegar, are used in this workshop.</p>	E	2	\$ 15
<p style="text-align: center;">“Embellish With Needle Felting”</p> <p>Participants will have the opportunity to explore and experiment with both single needle and with machine needle felting. Use our new Babylok embellishing machine to create a one-of-kind bookmark. The possibilities are limitless.</p>	E	3	\$ 25
<p style="text-align: center;">Felted Slipper Sock – knittability Series</p> <p>During this workshop you will learn the next level of knitting including working in the round, working short rows, picking up stitches, matching decreases, working a 3-needle bind-off and the basics of felting. This workshop is designed to build student’s knitting skills which will allow them to begin working on more complex projects. Introduction To Entrelac – knitability Series

The Entrelac stitch is often considered to be intimidating and written directions appear to be confusing. This workshop is designed to provide a hands-on approach to learning the Entrelac stitch. In addition to learning the fundamental Entrelac techniques, students will gain insights into tips and tricks for simplifying the process and improving the final product. The small size of the project allows for a minimal investment of time all the while gaining a complete understanding of the technique.

Pre-requisite Skills: Cast On; Knit and Purl; Decreases (SSK & P2tog); Working in the round.

Weaving In The Palm of Your Hand

Using a Weavette Loom, participants in this workshop will learn a basic weave pattern on this hand-held loom. Sizes range from 2”x2”; 2”x4”; 4”x4” and 6”x6”. We will cover how to thread the loom; how to weave the cloth; how to end the piece; and, how to stitch the pieces together. After this workshop, students may wish to explore weave pattern variations.
